## ELIGIBILITY

## We only accept handcrafted items by the vendors

We have a strict **NO RESALE** policy. This show is to exhibit **HANDCRAFTED** items produced by our vendors. If you attempt to sell wholesale/resale items, we will ask you to remove products and/or ask you to leave, and prohibit you from exhibiting again. All exhibitors must honestly disclose all information on the application, including all items to be sold.

# **BOOKING POLICY**

- All exhibitors must submit a completed application form with a photo of all crafts being sold and the appropriate fee enclosed. We will cash your check or process your credit card upon placement. You will not be placed until we receive payment . NO post-dated checks or money orders please.
- Applications will be processed in the order received and will be accepted until spaces are full. At that time applicants will be placed on a waiting list.
- Applications that are not completed in full will not be considered or held. Applicant will be notified of incompleteness by email or phone but will not be placed until completed.
- **No split fees accepted**. One application per booth. You are welcome to share a booth with another person(s) but only submit one application, please.
- NO SPOTS CAN BE GUARANTEED. We will attempt to accommodate the exhibitor's placement requests, however, We place in order received and best fit by category.

# FOOD SALES

If you plan to sell any food items you **MUST** indicate so on the application. If you are offering samples, please write "samples" in the description. **Food samples require a hand washing station at the booth supplied by the vendor,** in accordance with Iowa law. Exhibitors with food items are limited to the cafeterias in all schools. **Qualifying vendors need a Temporary Food License in the State of Iowa.** They must receive your applications at least 72 hours prior to the event. Failure to do so will result in ejection from the event and possibly denied future attendance.

## **BOOKING FEES**

Single Space: 12' wide x 9' deep = \$160 18' Space: 18' wide x 9' deep = \$235 Double Space: 24' Wide x 9' Deep = \$320

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# Due to credit card fees, there will be a \$5.00 charge to process <u>all</u> credit card applications. Double booths will be charged \$10.00.

## To avoid credit card fees, you may mail in a check <u>or come in person to the Ankeny Art Center to pay in cash.</u>

**Electricity**: A 300-watt outlet can be provided for \$10 to certain booth spaces. Exhibitors are encouraged to supply their own electric cords and surge protector

Chairs/Tables: Please indicate on the application if you would like tables and/or chairs. We will provide up to two 8' x 30" tables for \$10 per table and two chairs per booth for \$5 each for exhibitors requesting them

## OTHER INFORMATION

**Set Up/Tear Down Time:** Set up will be from 6am-9am on Saturday, November 2nd. **There is NO set up on Friday due to School District Policy.** Tear down will be from 3pm-5pm. Vendors should be torn down and cleaned up by 5pm.

**Food/Drinks:** Non-profit food vendors will offer breakfast, lunch, and drinks for sale in the cafeteria. There will be *free* coffee for exhibitors from 6am-8am in the cafeteria. **NO FOOD OR DRINK IS PERMITTED IN THE GYMS.** This is in accordance with school policy. Food is to stay in the cafeteria and hallways.

**Wi-Fi:** Wi-Fi is not offered in any areas of the schools. If you would like to accept credit cards electronically, please plan to bring your own hotspot or wireless device. *We will not provide any technical support for internet access.* 

Parking: All facilities have ground level access for unloading and loading. Vehicles may not be parked on the grass at any time. No parking or leaving trailers on school property overnight.

**\*\*Other:** Ankeny Art Center does not provide booth sitters during the day, please plan accordingly.

## **REFUND POLICY**

Cancellations made before August 1st will be refunded 100%. Cancellations made between August 1 and September 30 will be refunded 50%. **No refunds** will be made for cancellations on or after October 1st. This includes vendors that cannot obtain an lowa temporary food sales license.
